We are now accepting new members for the 2022 tournament season. Meetings are the first Tuesday of each month at 6:30 pm at the Williamson Fire Department. Come join us for the best competition and the most fun you can have fishing in a bass club.

**Why the Tug Valley Bass Anglers are the best.**

1. First and foremost we are a BASS CLUB not a tournament trail.
2. We are the oldest bass club in the area. Formed in 1990 and operating for 31 years.
3. Our tournament format is angler / co-angler not combined weight buddy tournaments.
4. Co-anglers will have the option to fish in their own division or compete as an angler.
5. Tournament schedule is setup for the working man, making it easier to fish all the tournaments.
6. All tournaments are one day Sunday tournaments except for the two day "Club Classic".
7. (9) tournaments per year, usually (1) tournament per month, March through November.
8. (8) local tournaments and only (1) out of state.
9. 100% payback at each tournament. No money is ever held out for year end awards.
10. Year end payouts for the "Club Classic".
11. Year end payouts for the top finishers in the Club Champion points race.
12. We go by the rules.
13. Off limit no practice period before each tournament.
13. Livewells are checked before every tournament.
14. Every fish is measured.
15. Launch positions are drawn at each tournament.
16. Morning prayer to begin each tournament day.
16. Display of the flag and playing of the national anthem to begin each tournament.
17. Outstanding group of guys to compete against and learn from.

Note: (10) or more co-anglers will be required to have a separate CO-ANGLER division.
